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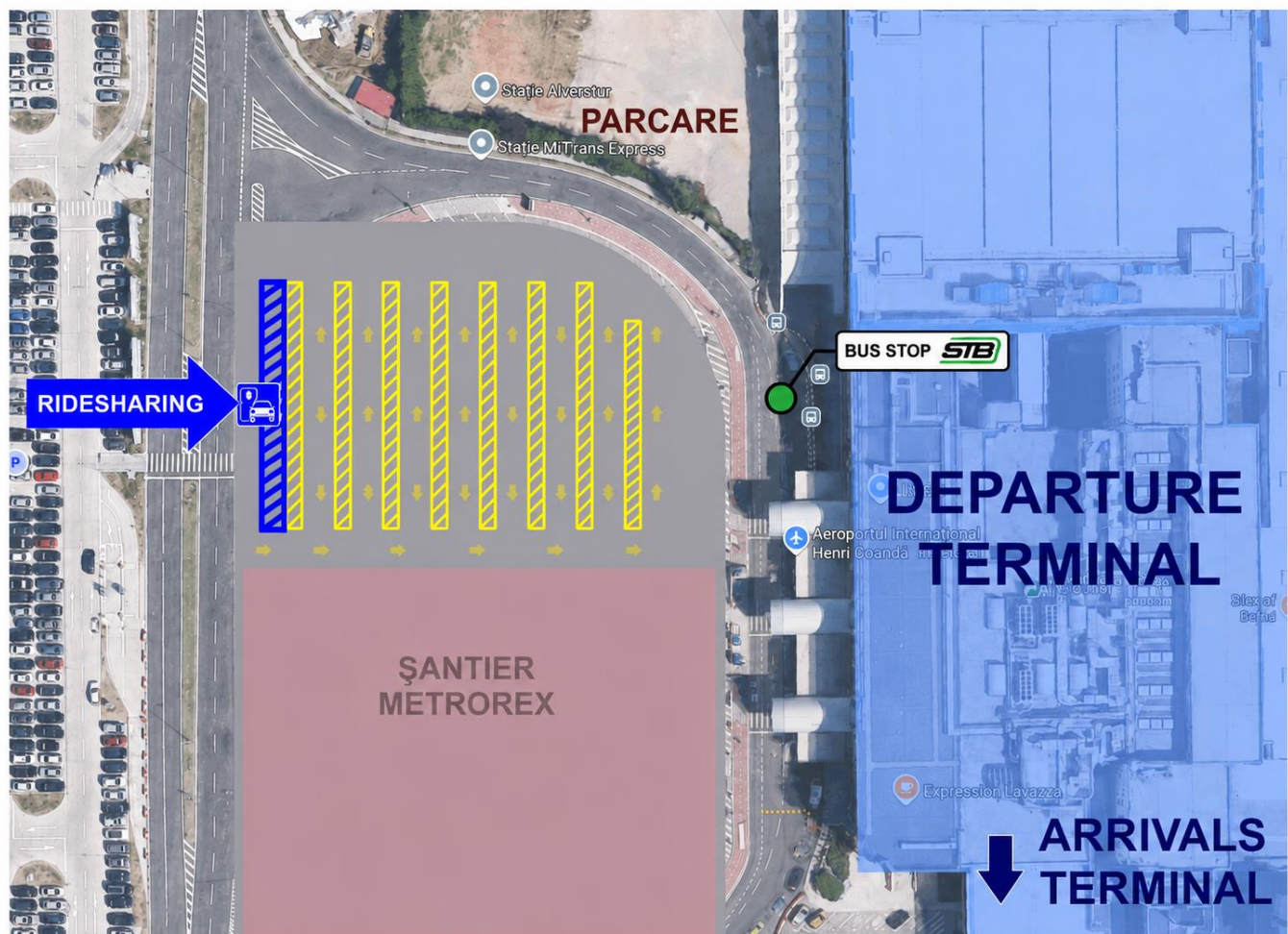


Practical Information

How to get from the airport to your accommodation

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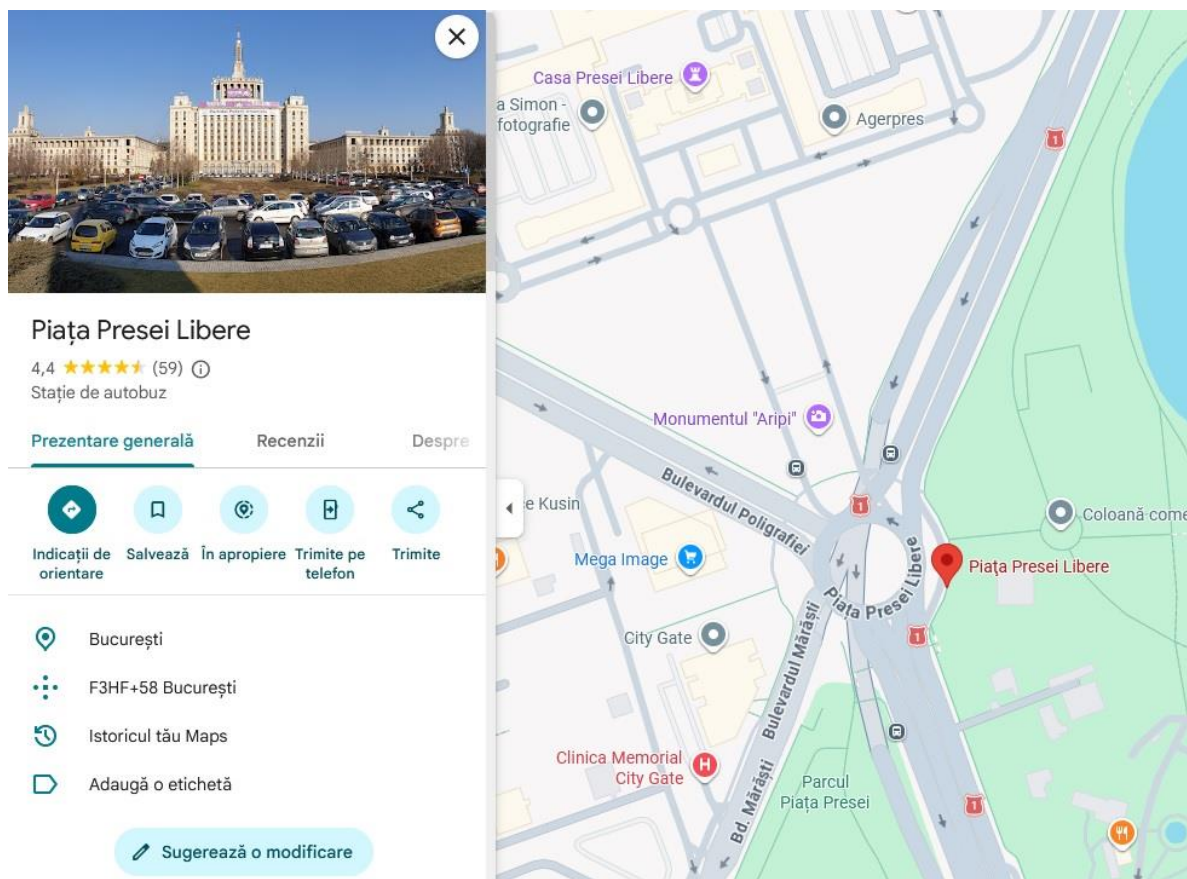


How to get to “Mihai Viteazul” National Intelligence Academy?
